Professorship in Ergonomics

(Universitätsprofessur, C4)

The successful candidate is expected to pursue a high quality research program with strong cross-disciplinary links. With an applied focus, the program should be well grounded in basic science; with a focus in basic research, significant implications for human work should be visible. Particularly welcome are approaches which make use of the potentials of recent developments in the cognitive neurosciences for the assessment and design of mental work, e.g. in the interaction with complex systems (systems ergonomics). Whereas the research is based at the *IfADo*, major contributions to the teaching of ergonomics as well as cooperations with the technical departments are part of the affiliation with Dortmund University.

Formal requirements for the position are specified by § 46, Hochschulgesetz NRW.

Qualified female scientists are explicitly encouraged to apply because the *IfADo* and Dortmund University strive for a higher proportion of female scientists. Priority is given to handicapped applicants with equal qualifications.
